The word "photography" was created from the Greek roots $\phi\omega\tau\dot{o}\varsigma$ (phōtos), genitive of $\phi\omega\varsigma$ (phōs), "light", and $\gamma\rho\alpha\dot{\phi}$ (graphé) "representation by means of lines" or "drawing", together meaning "drawing with light".

Formally known as Swan Hills Photographical Society, the Mundaring Camera Club is one of the oldest in WA, having been in existence since 1962. The purpose of the club is to learn and grow photographical ability in the local community and have fun at the same time.

The Club currently has 22 members ranging in skills from expert to beginner, with the more experienced photographers encouraged to share their knowledge through a positive learning environment.
